- 4. Do you think Candice made the right decision staying with Ian? What do you think her life would have been like with Kegan?
- 5. There are a lot of polar bear images in the book. Do you have an animal that gives you strength the way the bears do for Candice? If you do, why is it that particular animal?
- 6. How do you think Candice will do as a designer once she's trained? Do you think she has the artistic ability and business savvy to make it work?
- 7. Do you consider what Candice did, and what Ian did, to be cheating? What are the boundaries on acceptable behavior for married people?
